Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, from the Pastoral Search Committee of Spring Hill Missionary Baptist Church in Tuskegee, Alabama. We firmly believe that God calls pastors to shepherd His people (Jeremiah 3:15), and with prayerful hearts, we are seeking the individual whom God has chosen to become our Pastor—a shepherd after His own heart.

Our ideal Pastor will be a spiritually mature leader, a dynamic and effective preacher/teacher with a continually growing relationship with Jesus Christ. We are looking for someone whose behavior both inside and outside the church is exemplary, a visionary leader who can discern and communicate God's vision while effectively implementing it through a team-oriented approach. Leadership skills in fostering unity among teams, navigating intergenerational dynamics, and mentoring to enhance the effectiveness of church staff, auxiliaries, and ministries are highly valued.

Furthermore, we seek a Pastor who is a skilled communicator, capable of spreading the Word of God powerfully through biblically based teaching and preaching, nurturing discipleship among our congregation. Humility, integrity, and compassion for both the church and the community are essential traits we desire in our Pastor. We envision our Pastor to be personable and approachable, embracing a cooperative and hospitable manner, while exhibiting emotional intelligence characteristics such as self-awareness, self-discipline, motivation, and empathy in their relationships with SHMBC leaders, members, and external community leaders. We aim to continue shining as a beacon of hope, drawing others to Christ Jesus.

Spring Hill Missionary Baptist Church has proudly served the rural community of Tuskegee, Alabama for over 125 years, and our congregation currently consists of around 85-100 members. We seek a candidate whose qualifications and giftedness align with 1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:6-9, 1 Timothy 5:17, 2 Timothy 2:24-25 (Holy conduct), Malachi 3:10 (Tither), and Galatians 5:22-23 (Christian Conduct).

The successful candidate will possess the following qualifications and responsibilities, which include but are not limited to:

- Plan and conduct worship services, prepare and deliver sermons, and serve as the lead in the observance of ordinances (Baptism and the Lord's Supper).
- Lead and teach members and visitors in weekly prayer meetings and Bible Study, membership classes, and discipleship training.
- Visit the sick and shut-in upon request.
- Lead the Church's evangelical growth and effectiveness beyond the walls of the Church.
- Establish a presence in the community with outreach programs and projects.
- Inspire and motivate church members to operate in a spirit of excellence while using their gifts and talents for God.
- Provide pastoral counseling, perform wedding ceremonies, conduct funerals, and perform dedication services of children.
- Lead in planning, organizing, directing, coordinating, and evaluating the Church ministries.
- Work with the leadership and members as they perform their assigned responsibilities and facilitate their training.
- Preside over all business meetings of the Church.
- Work with the leadership and finance department to manage the varied resources of the congregation with effectiveness and efficiency.
- Support and participate with the local district and the National Baptist Convention USA Inc., with which Spring Hill Missionary Baptist is affiliated.
- Must have a clear understanding of the Baptist Doctrine and Articles of Faith.
- Must be an effective communicator, demonstrate the ability to prepare and deliver biblically sound lessons and messages.
- Prefer a record of community involvement.
- Must be committed to church growth and membership retention.
- Must be able to articulate a vision for the church that emphasizes spiritual growth and development.
- The pastor must serve to provide spiritual leadership that will lead the congregation to live in service for Christ.
